

EAWOP Small Group Meetings (SGM)- Template for proposals

- Strategic SGM proposal
- Title of the SGM
- Description of the SGM, including a rationale for its importance for European work and organizational Psychology (WOP)

[NB: Rationale for the SGM importance to building bridges between different associations and groups of interest that share interests in WOP <u>to briefly</u> sustain the strategic relevance. Proposals should higlight a) impact of the collaboration between parties for the field of WOP, particularly EAWOP; b) policy, research, and practical implications of the collaboration; c) scope wide, bearing in mind the diversity of EAWOP members (countries/academic and practitioner topics); d) plan for an enduring collaboration between parties]

Dates and place of the meeting

(NB: please note that the distribution of the open call for papers/contributions requires substantial lead-time for interested parties to respond well in time for the meeting);

- Organizing committee and contact person;
- Budget, including plans to secure additional funding;
- Participant Fees Expected

[it is explicitly meant for not-for-profit meetings only – funding is meant to keep costs to participating EAWOP members at a minimum (participation fees are always subject to EAWOP EC approval and in any situation cannot exceed the maximum of 120€ regular fee/60€ student fee]

- Plan for the distribution of the call for papers/contributions, as well as the proposed wording of the SGM call announcement;
- Names of 10 EAWOP members plus other committed supporters of the event from at least <u>four different countries</u> committed to participating in the meeting (NB: this is to assess the viability of the meeting; with the remainder of participant places being open to competition).

Recommended format:

- Full proposal size around 7 to 10 pages
- Font size 11 or 12
- Space between lines of 1,5
